

# Lynn Haven Church CityServe 2018 FAQ

## **What time does CityServe 2018 start?**

April 21, 2018

8:00 am Breakfast and prayer at Kinsaul Park

8:30 am Meet with your project team and depart for your project site

## **What time does my project end?**

We're asking all projects to finish up by 12pm. Please head back to Kinsaul Park immediately following your project completion for a cookout celebration lunch!

## **Do I need to bring anything to my project?**

Materials needed are listed on the project sign-up sheets and on the "Signup.com" online sign up pages. Any additional information will be provided by your Project Leader.

## **Do I need to bring lunch or water?**

You need to bring your own water and snacks. A cookout lunch is being held at Kinsaul Park immediately following the completion of your project.

## **How do I know where my project is?**

You will receive an email or phone call from your Project Leader the week before CityServe. All teams will gather at the Kinsaul Park to begin the day. If you do not hear from your Project Leader by April 13th, please contact Cindy Rounds at [cindy.rounds@me.com](mailto:cindy.rounds@me.com) or 850-532-5395.

## **Do I need to come to Kinsaul park first? Or can I go straight to my project?**

Yes, all teams should gather at the Kinsaul Park at 8am on April 21st unless you have made arrangements otherwise with your project leader.

**What should I wear?** Many people will choose to wear their Lynn Haven UMC Serve Team shirts- they will be available to purchase for \$10 the morning of the event (first come, first served). If you do not have a Serve shirt, wear a red t-shirt. Wear clothes appropriate for the project you are serving at. Your Project Leader will give you more information about this.

## **What if it rains?**

If it rains, and you are on an outdoor project, you will receive instructions from your Project Leader. If it is raining, breakfast and prayer will be held at the 4501 Transmitter Rd. campus of Lynn Haven UMC.
