



Church Re-Gathering Phase 3

*Phase 3 will begin **January 25, 2021** and continue for a period of time TBD*

Face Coverings/Masks: Face coverings are required for **everyone** attending in-person activities unless a proper social distance of at least six feet is maintained. According to CDC guidelines, the only exceptions to this policy are children 2 and younger and persons who have trouble breathing. Masks are available at the front entrance for anyone needing one.

Sick Policy: If you are sick (fever, cough, feeling unwell, etc.) or if you are at a high risk for serious health complications should you contract COVID-19, please do not come to in-person activities.

Sunday Worship Schedule:

8:30 am: Features traditional elements and music.

10 am: Features a more contemporary worship style.

Online Worship: The 10 am service is live-streamed. If you prefer not to wear a mask, please join us for our online service as an alternative.

Seating: Seating in the Worship Center is limited to 50 percent of room capacity with extra spacing between rows. Room occupancy throughout the building will not exceed 50 percent of capacity for each space.

Parking/Entry/Exit: The front portion of the parking lot is reserved for handicapped individuals, senior adults, and parents of small children. Parking for everyone else is available on the sides of the building and across the street in the school parking lots.

Tithes and Offerings: Offering receptacles are located throughout the building for touch-free giving. Additional ways to give are listed at mylhumc.net/give.

Communion: Communion will be celebrated the first Sunday of each month using pre-packaged sets. Those worshipping virtually can participate at home with any type of bread/cracker and juice.

Sunday Children's Church: Children's Church programs are available during the 10 am Sunday service. Reservations are required and can be made at mylhumc.net/kids. Walk-ins are accepted when space is available.

AWANA Club: Our children's discipleship program, AWANA Club, will continue to meet on alternating Wednesday nights (Group A and Group B). New members can sign up at mylhumc.net/kids.

Student Ministry: Lynn Haven UMC Youth Group will continue Wednesday and Sunday Youth Group activities, but instead of one night for middle school and one night for high school, ALL students are welcome and encouraged to attend both evenings. Small Groups/Bible Studies: The Pastors' Wednesday Night Bible Study has resumed with options to attend in person or to watch live on Facebook or YouTube. Other Bible Study or Small Group leaders are invited to reserve space in the building for in-person meetings and to utilize options such as Zoom or Skype for virtual meetings. For groups that meet on Wednesday nights, a limited number of childcare (nursery) spots are available. Fellowship/Hospitality: Food and beverages will not be served at church-wide gatherings. A water fountain with a touchless (sensor-activated) water bottle refill station is available in the lobby near the restrooms.

Safety/Sanitation: A cleaning crew will sanitize restrooms and all common areas before and in between services. All attendees are encouraged to wash hands often. Hand sanitizer is readily available throughout the building.
