## Sacred 4-Letter Words: LOVE

Three things will last forever – faith, hope, and love – and the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13:13 NLT

Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind...[and] love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:37, 39 NLT

God is love...God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. 1 John 4:8, 12 NIV

We love because [God] first loved us.

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 


